Description: Former Minister's house of mid to late 19th century date. Brick and flint walls, two-storey symmetrical form. Flat arches to window heads now rendered. Central door, flush timber casement windows in reveals, natural slate gabled roof. Locally significant due to combination of age, intactness, vernacular architectural quality, group value, and direct association with adjacent Chapel.
