Description: Flanking walls to former north entrance to Sherfield Manor (now Sherfield House School), circa 1896 to design of Fairfax Blomfield Wade and/or C.Frankiss. Pair of curved low red brick walls in Flemish bond with moulded stone coping to identical profile as western entrance to Sherfield School. Original gate piers missing, and former wrought iron gates now hung at new entrance to estate on other side of by-pass. Locally significant due to architectural quality, and association with nationally notable architects.

Ground floor guards office with five doors and two crittal windows beneath cantilevered concrete veranda. Upper floor is fortified pill box with two machine gun slots overlooking gate and entrance. Single brick chimney towards rear. Locally significant due to historic interest due to origins as part of mid C20 UK defence infrastructure and local rarity.

Old timber casement windows with chamfered mullions and frames with gauged brick arches above. Locally significant due to architectural quality and intactness.
