Description: Village hall and attached managers house, c1899. Long main hall range to southern end. Two storey managers house to northern end. Red brick in flemish bond with fine joint work.. Large clay tile roof with half gable to southern end with timber frame exposed beneath chamfered timber barge board. Square bay window to front with gable over, with exposed timber frame beneath barge board. Wellington plaque and 1899 inscription. Managers house similar style, with rough-cast render to first floor. Canted bay windows, lean to porch, oriel windows to first floor. Metal casements in timber subframes throughout. Vented turret on ridge of hall. Locally significant architectural quality, intactness, social importance to village and group value.
