Description: Public house of early 19th century date and modern. Front and core of building of earlier date, with some later C19 additions, extensive modern additions to rear, but largely concealed from front. Painted brick, natural slate hipped and gabled roofs, timber sash windows in reveals and flush timber casement windows, including two canted-bay windows flanking the central front door, beneath a leaded canopy to front.

Locally significant to landscape, group value, age and intactness.

Description: Barn of early to mid 19th century date. Aisled and timber-framed construction of five bays. Hipped tin-clad roof, weather-boarded walls beneath low eaves on top of a brick plinth. Central cart entrances to both sides beneath eaves. Significant locally due to historic character, group value, landscape value, age and intactness.

Locally significant as attractive and intact examples of their period.
