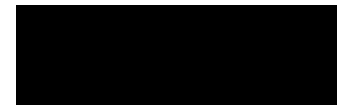

	1.1 2 and 3 Viables Cottages Basingstoke budget: To increase the approved budget by £0.070M for the 2022/23 financial year.	Previously, the funding that had been approved was based on estimates from consultants for the total cost of the refurbishment. However, quotes have now been received following a rigorous procurement process and the costs are higher than anticipated. It is therefore proposed that £0.070M of additional Section 106 funding is allocated to this project in order to take the total cost to £0.200M, which will fund the full refurbishment costs, consultancy costs and at least some elements of the 'desirables', with discussions to continue with Julian House should there be any elements they are able to fund should the total exceed this amount.
