	1.1 CCTV Cameras for Fly-tipping Surveillance budget: To increase the approved budget by £0.050M in the 2022/23 financial year.	The council has secured grant funding £0.050M from The Waste and Resources Action Programme (WRAP) to provide funding for permanent CCTV equipment at six recycling bring sites. This will provide constant monitoring of all sites as a means of obtaining evidence of any fly tipping offences. It will also provide a visual deterrent at the sites and drastically reduce officer time associated with deployment of the previously planned moveable CCTV equipment.
