19 th October 2020	<p>The Executive Director of Corporate Services (S151 Officer) under delegated powers, and following recommendation of the Council Capital Board, has taken the decision to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rephase section 106 funds totalling £0.116M relating to Community Facilities that are currently in 2021/22 and 202/23 into 2020/21. • Approve the addition of £0.051M of unallocated section 106 community facilities funds into the programme for 2020/21. <p>Through these two approvals the total 2020/21 Community Facilities budget will be increased to £0.279M.</p>	<p>Following the Covid-19 lockdown a number of communities are coming forward with requests for s106 funding to take forward improvements projects which they had not previously had time to develop and will enable them to better prepare for the Covid-19 recovery.</p> <p>The additional projects supported by this funding will be: Buckskin MUGA - The project is aimed at improving the games area for young people as well as addressing some anti-social behaviour issues that it attracts. Chineham Projects - Including toilet improvements at the community school, installation of solar panels at the village hall and a range of improvements at the church hall which is used by the wider community.
