2. Health and Wellbeing Partnership update – Lucy Dennis

Lucy's presentation focused on health need projections and the impact of population growth and changing demographics on healthcare needs and infrastructure. Please see attached PowerPoint for more information. The board questioned what data was used and the increase in particular disease, Lucy's response was "PHOF (Public Health Outcomes Framework) data was used it relates to GP registration lists. With respect to the question around increasing disease such as mental health, blood pressure stroke etc. the increased incidences may be somewhat affected by the growing population however the data team feel this is not the primary cause for the trend."

3. Brexit Update – Di Bromley
