



## Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council Annual CIL Rate Summary for: 2020

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge that local authorities in England and Wales can levy on new development in their area. The funds generated from CIL are used to support infrastructure projects that are needed as a result of development, such as transport, schools, and green spaces.

In accordance with Regulation 121C of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Regulations 2010 (as amended), Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council is required to publish an Annual CIL Rate Summary.

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is subject to indexation, allowing the rates to be adjusted for inflation.

The council agreed to [adopt the Community Infrastructure Levy \(CIL\) and supporting policies on 22 March 2018](#), and CIL was brought into effect on 25 June 2018. This is the [notice of adoption](#) of the CIL Charging Schedule.
