Grants were used to directly support children, enabling the purchase of basic essentials such as clothing, school uniforms and food. Funding was also used to provide one to one targeted support to families facing an emergency or in crisis due to the cost of living.	£ 4,000.00
Norden Community Association	1094516	Funding was used to deliver a Citizens Advice Hub providing targeted and bespoke support to residents on a range of complex matters such as debt, benefits advice, utility and energy bills and housing costs as a result of the cost of living crisis.	£ 4,892.80
Tadley and District Community Association	301736	Funding was used to deliver cookery and sewing classes to support residents with the cost of living. The cookery classes enabled participants how to make hearty and healthy meals within a budget with advice on how to purchase ingredients, adapt recipes and to keep costs low. Stop Domestic Abuse	1146773	Funding was used to provide essential household items such as food, clothing and toiletries to support families affected by domestic abuse in the borough.	£ 5,000.00
CHE Community Café CIC	13995498	Funding was used to expand the services offered by the Orchard Community Café, to support residents affected by the cost of living. The Cafe provides a warm, friendly and safe space where arts and crafts and play are used to enable people to share their experiences and challenges. Residents can access	£ 4,500.00
Westside Community Association	1166532	Funding was used to provide help and support to promote healthy eating on a budget. Cookery sessions focussed on cooking from scratch, batch cooking and using leftovers and a free recipe books provided ideas for affordable meals.	£ 4,977.50
The YOU Trust	291489	Funding was used for a range of measures to support victims of domestic abuse. Grants of £500 were available to assist families with the cost of relocation, enabling them to purchase essential household items.
