

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Hampshire in accordance with Section 39 (3) of the Act of 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III, Paragraph 20 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order will be The Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2025.

The effect of the Order will be:-

To revoke all the amendment orders to the 2019 order and consolidate them into one new up to date off-street order. The opportunity has also been taken to make a number of changes to the order to provide clarity and to reflect the situation which currently exists in the car parks. Those amendments include:

- Remove the provision for Hip Dysplasia Permits as these permits no longer exist.
- Change the drawing number for Alencon Link Lower Deck Car Park from no.20 to no.2, and re-number subsequent plans. The numbers on the plans will then correspond with the numbers on the order to provide clarity and ease of reference.
- Remove the provision for pay and display parking in Feathers Yard as these bays have been changed to electric vehicle charging bays.
- Change charging hours to 'all times', where appropriate, for consistency of wording.
- Add a provision for virtual permits.
- Remove permit provision for Bell Street Car Park as this car park now operates as a free car park and permits are no longer necessary.

No objections have been received to the proposed order and the order has now been made with minor modifications to the paragraph numbering.

This Order will come into operation on 4 October 2025

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 14 November 2025 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
