

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2025 (AMENDMENT NO 1)
(DIBLEY CLOSE, OAKRIDGE HALL FOR ALL COMMUNITY CENTRE, SCHUBERT ROAD, THE
WINKLE AND UPPER SHERBORNE ROAD CAR PARK) ORDER 2025**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Hampshire in accordance with Section 39 (3) of the Act of 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III, Paragraph 20 (1) of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order is the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2025 (Amendment No 1) (Dibley Close, Oakridge Hall for All Community Centre, Schubert Road, The Winkle and Upper Sherborne Road Car Park) Order 2025

The effect of the Order will be:-

To add the following car parks to the Off-Street Parking Order to formalise parking within these car parks:

Dibley Close – general parking, disabled parking and electric vehicle charging places

Oakridge Hall for All Community Centre – Electric vehicle charging places

Schubert Road – general parking, disabled parking and electric vehicle charging places (Monday – Friday limited to 5 hours)

The Winkle - General parking, disabled parking and electric vehicle charging places

Upper Sherborne Road Car Park - General parking, disabled parking and electric vehicle charging places

Date of Operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 14 February 2026.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 27 March 2026 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
