THE HAMPSHIRE (BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL)
(HEATH END ROAD, WELLINGTON CRESCENT, BISHOPSWOOD LANE,
BRIMPTON ROAD) (STREET CLOSURE) ORDER 2026

Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Town and Police Clauses Act 1847 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby makes the following order for the prevention of obstruction of Heath End Road, Wellington Crescent, Bishopswood Lane, Brimpton Road, during the Remembrance Sunday.

1. No person shall cause any vehicle including pedal cycles to proceed along the road referred to in Schedule 1 below.
2. Emergency vehicles and official vehicles shall be exempt from the restriction contained in Clause 1.
3. The penalty for contravening this Order is a fine not exceeding Level 3 on the Standard Scale.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
5. This Order will be effective on the date and at the times shown in Schedule 1 below.
6. This Order may be cited as The Hampshire (Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council) (Heath End Road, Wellington Crescent, Bishopswood Lane, Brimpton Road) (Street Closure) Order 2026.

		In its entirety from its junction with Brimpton Road to its junction with Heath End Road for 10 minutes from 10.40am.
08 November 2026	10:30am - 12:00pm	Bishopswood Lane (10 minute closure)
		At its junction with Heath End Road for 10 minutes from 10.40 am

		Brimpton Road (50 minute closure) From its junction with Wolverton Road to a point approximately 25m north of its junction with Heath End Road for 50 minutes from 10.50 am

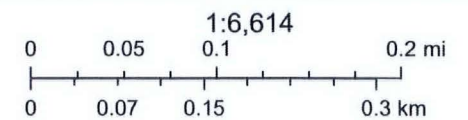

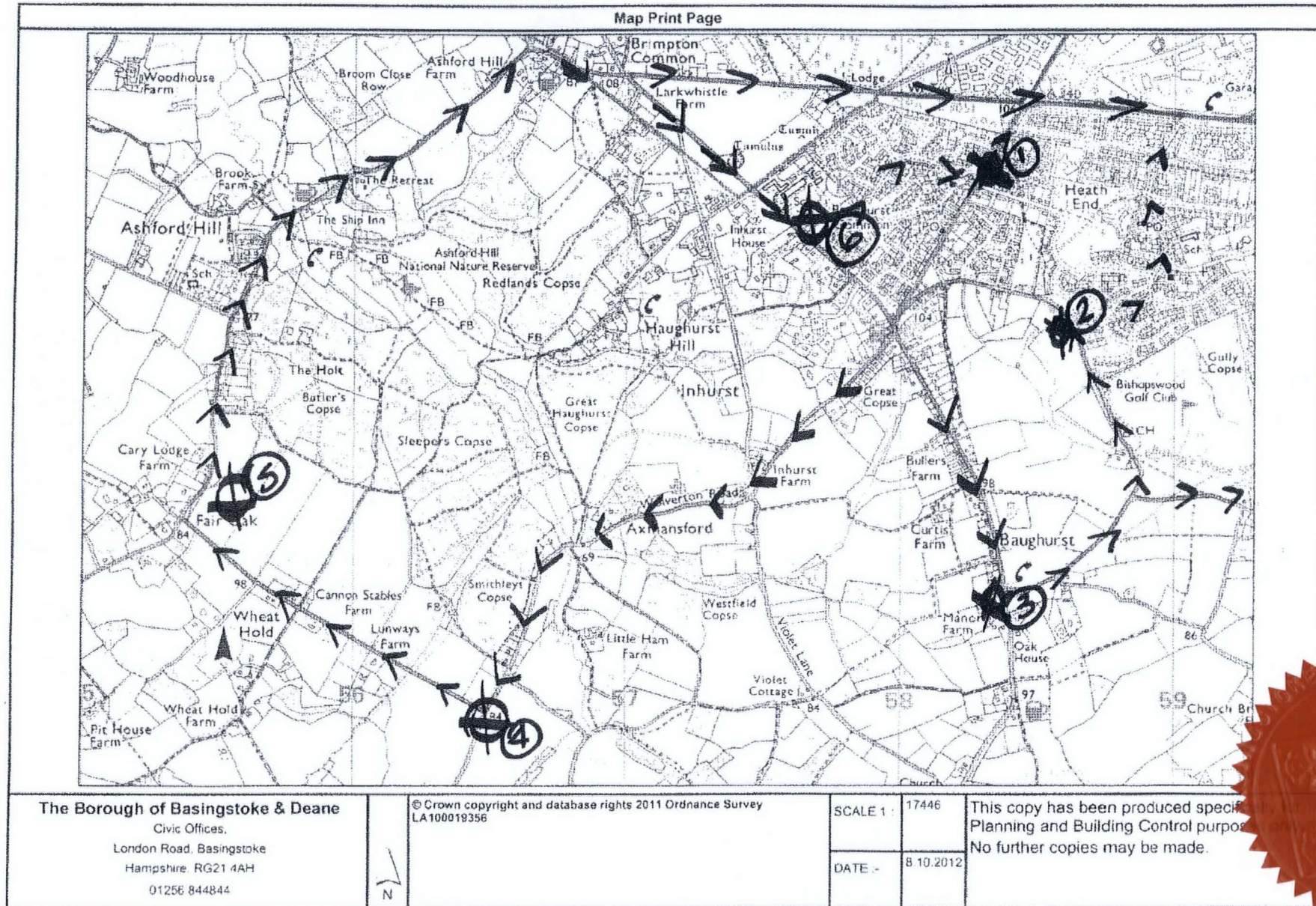

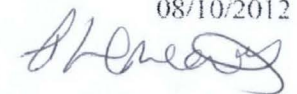
